

On Wednesday December 21st, 80 teenagers from St. Charles-St. Ann's and St. Joseph's in Camillus visited Bellevue Elementary School for a Christmas morning. Every year for the past 10 years, teens have visited different Elementary Schools with gifts, coloring books and crayons and snacks. Our teenagers receive a gift tag with a child's name in the 2nd grade and that teenager purchases a stuffed animal specifically for that child to take home for Christmas. At 9am in the morning on December 21st, the teens met with the child for a one-on-one 2 hour visit. The stuffed bear, bunny, troll, ninja turtle is given to the 2nd grader and a friendship begins. They share stories about their families, they color, they sing Christmas carols and have snacks. The last part of the visit, the children take the teens to their classrooms. In the classrooms they read to each other, play board games or just continue to share stories. For some of these children, this gift is the only present they will receive. It is the favorite event that our YIM group does and even our college students join us for the event. A huge thanks to Westhill School District for allowing the use of a bus to transport the teens. Thank you to the parents for allowing their teenagers to miss school that morning and thanks to our adults who helped chaperone. But most of all, thank you to the 50 teens from our parish who donated the bears and helped to make a child's Christmas special. There were tears when we left by the children, the teachers and the teens – it was the perfect way to start the Christmas season




