

The blessing of the home is a popular Epiphany custom. Above the entrance door of your home, mark the following inscription

20+ C+M+B+ 17. The numbers represent the year; the initials represent Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar, the names of the three wise men in legend.

The inscription also stands for Christus Mansionem Benedicat, which means "Christ Bless this home." The inscription remains about the doorway until Pentecost.

Let us pray: O Lord, God, bless this creature chalk to make it helpful to humankind. Grant that we who use it with faith and inscribe with it upon the entrance of our homes may enjoy physical health and spiritual protection. Through Christ our Lord, Amen.




