



J. speaks of his own hearing disability when stricken with a sudden sensorineural hearing loss,— origin unknown. He speaks of his journey and how it has taken him seven years to adjust—Father admits he is still learning. "I know that many people have far more challenging disabilities than mine, For example, that while people are often sympathetic toward those who are visually impaired, they can be quite impatient and even rude with people who are hearing impaired. People resent having to repeat something because I didn't hear it, or they get frustrated because I didn't hear the punchline of their joke and now their timing is ruined. Sometimes they just say "forget about it."

"Forget about it" is just about the most offensive thing you can say to someone with hearing loss. If it was important enough to say in the first place, then say it again.

For the most part, however people are understanding and compassionate. The experience reminds me that I have many people in my life who love me and care about me. Now in some way I am more in touch with the world's pain, with the countless challenges seen and unseen, that so many people encounter every day."

When we listen to the stories of people living with disabilities, we all benefit. Those who are disabled, so often excluded and ignored, are the source of God's grace. They are our closest encounter with Jesus.
