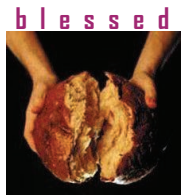

Bus leaves Wegmans' in Dewitt on January 21, 2016 at 11:30pm and returns January 22 at 11:30pm on January 22nd.

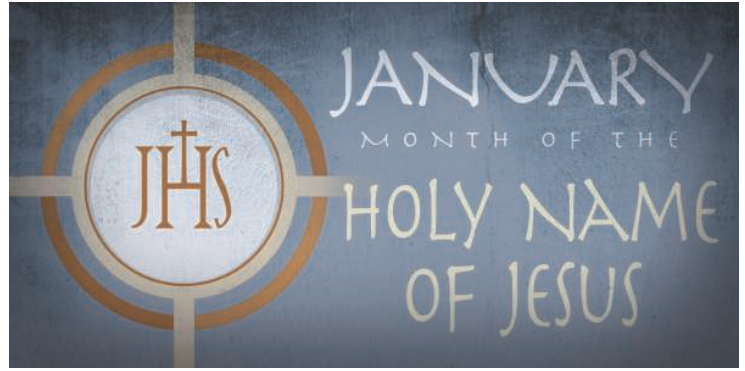

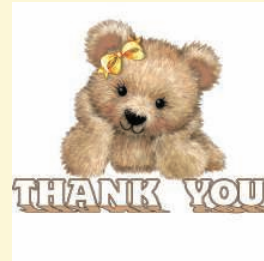

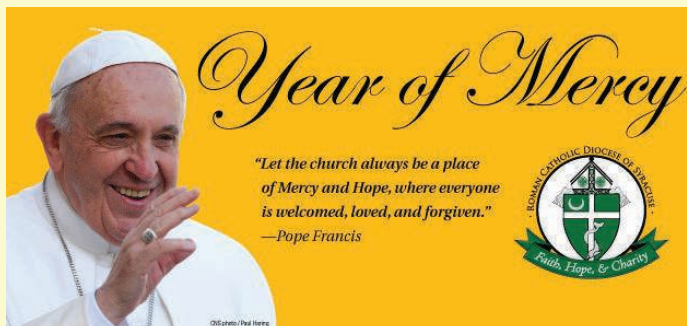
