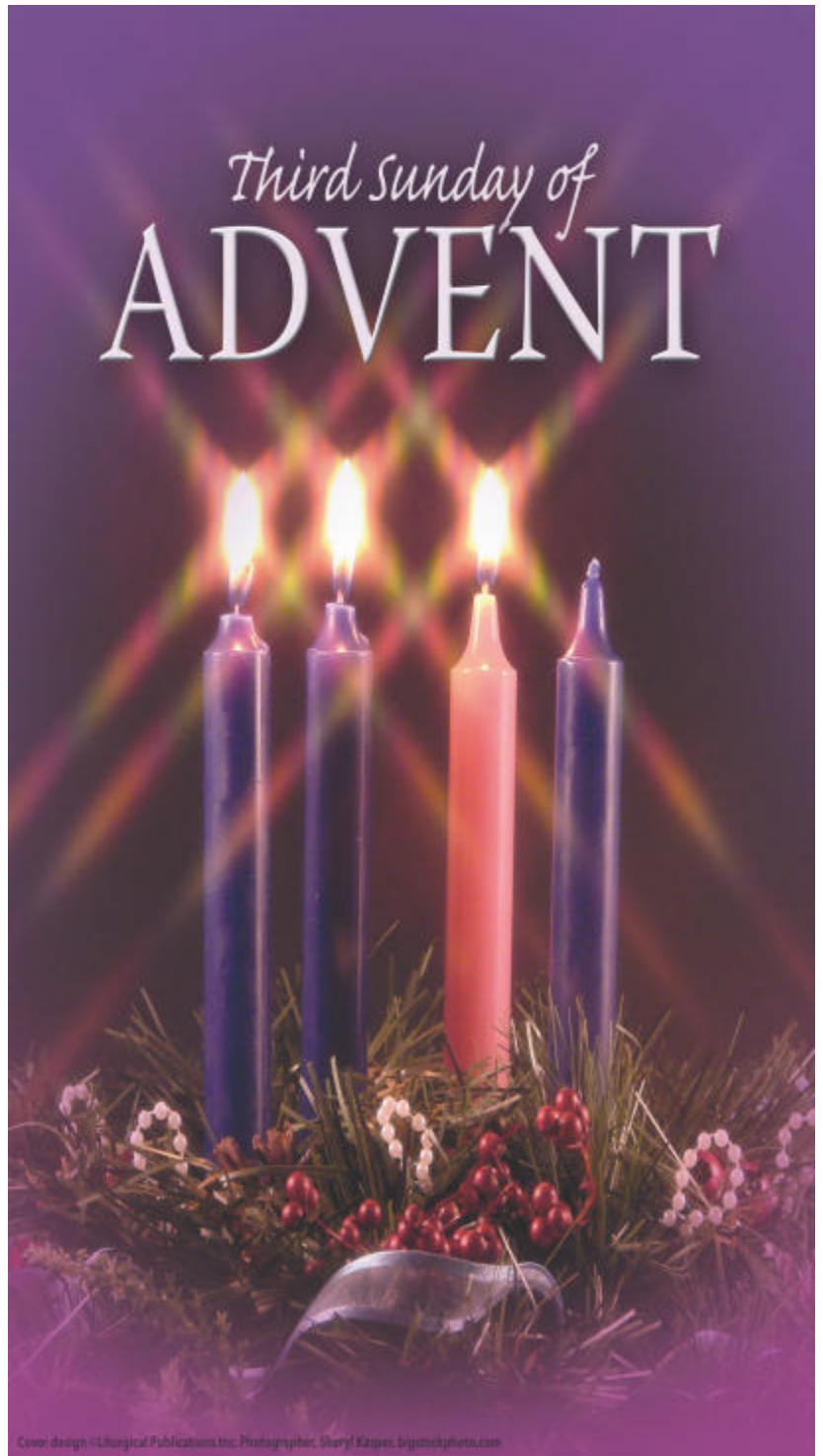

Please sign up on the sheets in the gathering space or call Deacon Tony if you are interested in participating for these two Masses, or would like to join the ushers already serving at Masses.

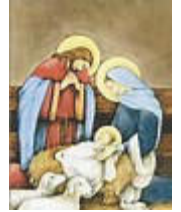
