Lent: The Spirituality of the Season In the movement from winter's darkness to spring's increasing vitality, we are invited to move out of our personal lethargy to new life and coming to life in new ways. We will unpack the spirituality of Lent as a season of baptismal remembrance and preparation. The question for you is: What would bring you more fully to life this Lent? This miniretreat will help you come up with some answers. Mass and ashes will be offered at 11:45 am. Wednesday, March 1; 10-3pm

Fr. Tom Ryan, a Paulist priest based in Boston will direct this retreat.

Respect Unbeknownst to many of our fellow citizens, a particularly heinous method of abortion is being carried out all across America. It's called dismemberment abortion.

Dismemberment abortion involves killing an unborn baby through tearing him or her apart limb by limb using instruments such as forceps or scissors. The baby's body parts are then extracted from the womb.

In this gruesome procedure, the unborn baby dies as anyone subjected to bodily dismemberment would: by bleeding to death.

Numerous states have recognized the brutality of this practice and have passed bills to ban it. Our mission is to make New York next on this list.

A growing body of scientific evidence shows that unborn babies as early as 20 weeks after fertilization experience pain. At this stage, an unborn child has developed all the physical structures required to feel pain and, in fact physically reacts to painful stimuli.

A dozen states in the country have recognized the urgent need to protect infants capable of feeling the excruciating pain of abortion through the adoption of the "Pain-capable Unborn Child Protection Act. With hard work and determination New York can join the ranks.



We ask that you continue to spread the word about the clothing shed to other community members. Thank you for your support.


