### ADORATION OF OUR LORD

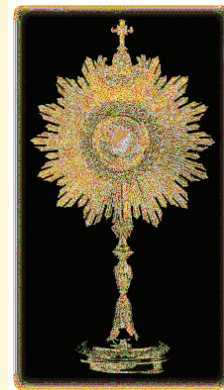
“Be still and know that I am God” ... Psalm 45

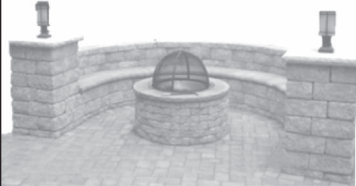

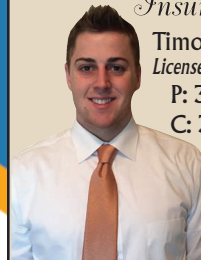
