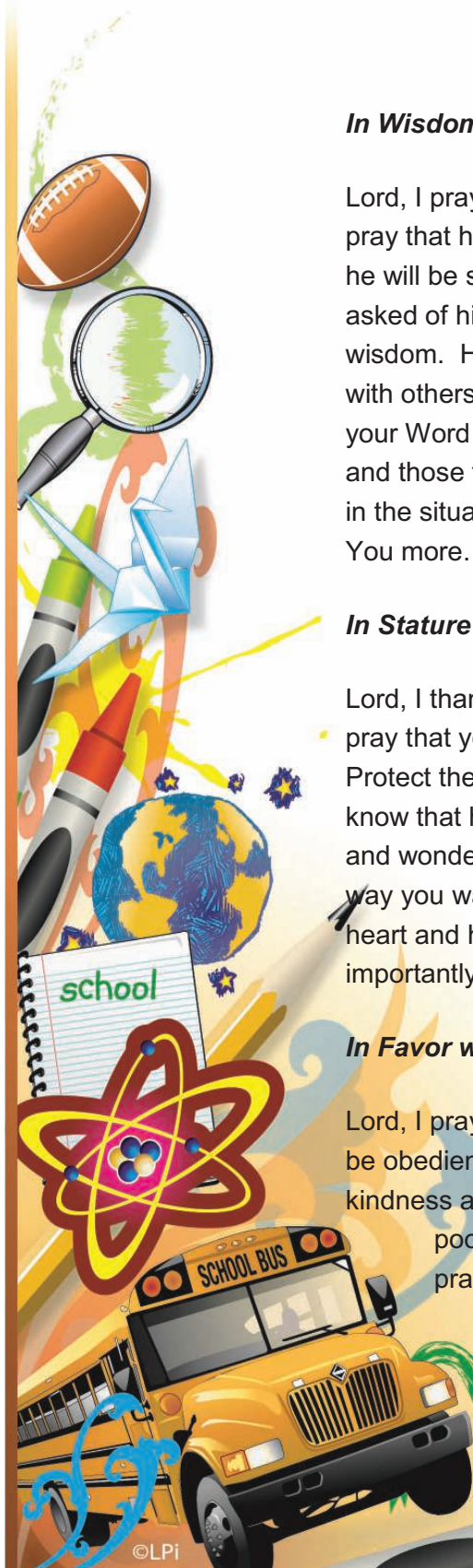
In Stature
