

Did you know?

Women with a history of abortion have higher rates of anxiety (34%) higher), depression (37% higher), alcohol use/misuse (110%) ... and suicidal behavior (155%), compared to those who have not had an abortion."

Male responses to a partner's abortion include grief, guilt, depression, anxiety, feelings of repressed emotions, helplessness/voicelessness/powerlessness, post traumatic stress, anger and relationship problems.






