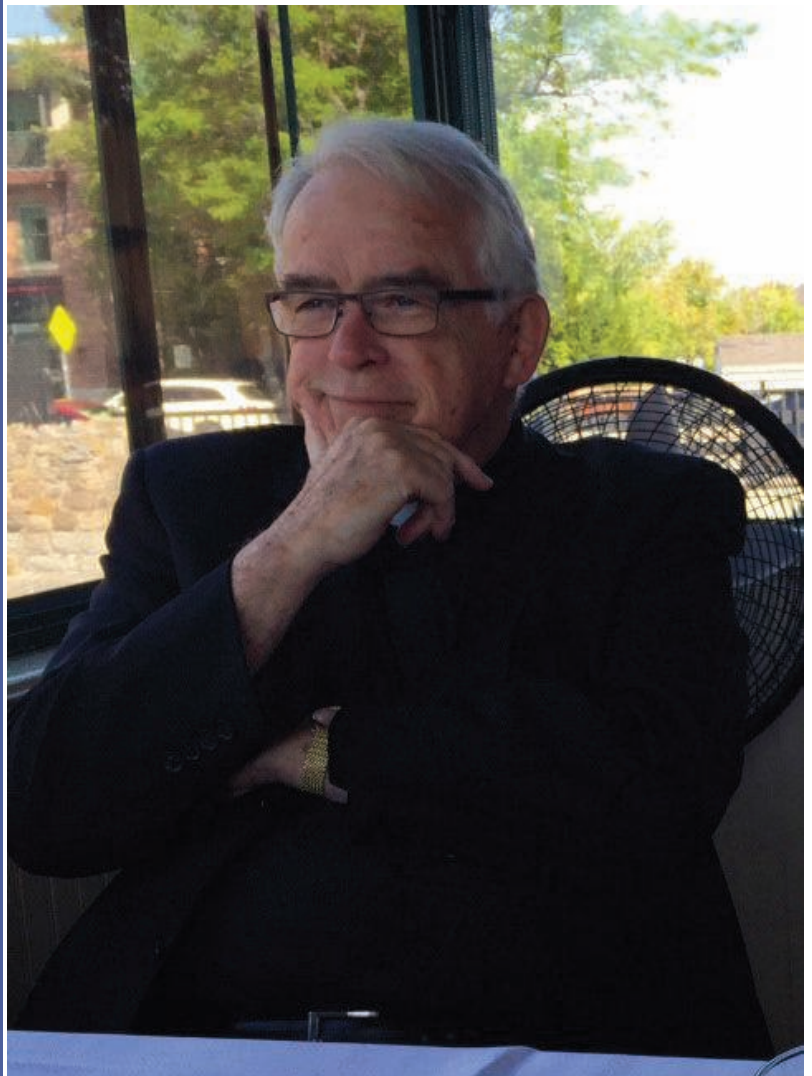

Did you know?

Women with a history of abortion have higher rates of anxiety (34% higher), depression (37% higher), alcohol use/misuse (110%) ... and suicidal behavior (155%), compared to those who have not had an abortion."

Male responses to a partner's abortion include grief, guilt, depression, anxiety, feelings of repressed emotions, helplessness/voicelessness/powerlessness, post traumatic stress, anger and relationship problems.

Registration is also required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. You must be a registered, contributing member for at least three months before a certificate is provided.

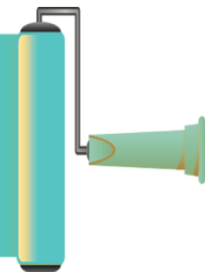
