

RESPECT LIFE

When the latest Planned Parenthood annual report was finally released in May, it provided even more reasons why the abortion giant should not continue to be subsidized by taxpayers.

The report showed that while the number of abortions increased by 5,000 over the prior year, fewer women are turning to Planned Parenthood for healthcare services.

The report revealed a sharp decline in prenatal services, down from 17,419 the prior year to just 9,419 last year. And despite repeated claims to the contrary, Planned Parenthood continues not to provide any mammograms at all.

At the same time, Planned Parenthood last year raked in more than \$550 million dollars from U.S. taxpayers in government health service grants and reimbursements.

Both Steven and Madison attend Bishop Ludden and another student from Ludden, Mairead McIntyre, was kind enough to proclaim a decade in Spanish. We were honored to have a young woman from the Basilica of the Sacred Heart, Mirka Banach, pray in Polish. Members of each of our classes finished the rosary in English and our Seniors, Kate Graziano and Michael Lychowid helped to lead us in the prayers for peace. A huge thanks to Keith Condon for lending his musical talents to enhance our rosary and thanks to all who came to Vioil with us. St. John Paul II calls the Rosary the Weapon For Peace. May we turn to Mary in our cry for peace and may she pray for us and intercede to her Son for an end to war and hatred.






