



From the desk of Deacon Tony....Please mark your calendars!

This year, the 4th Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve. That means **that there is Mass on Christmas Eve morning for the 4th Sunday of Advent, and then Mass on Christmas Eve for Christmas.** It would be very difficult to have our normal Sunday morning Masses, given the number of Masses that day. Therefore, the schedule for the 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas Eve/Day is as follows:

**4th Sunday of Advent**- we will have our normal Vigil Masses on Saturday: **4:00pm at St. Patrick's and 5:15pm at St. Charles. On Sunday morning, we will have 8:00am Mass at St. Ann's and 9:00am Mass at St. Patrick's. There will be NO 10:30am Mass.**

**Christmas Eve/Day Masses**- on Sunday, Christmas Eve, there will be a **4:00 pm Mass at St. Patrick's and a 4:00pm at St. Charles, and a 5:30 Mass at St. Ann's (gym).** On Monday, Christmas Day, **8:00am at St. Ann's, 9:30am at St. Patrick's and 11:00am at St. Charles.**




