This year, the 4th Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve. That means **that there is Mass on Christmas Eve morning for the 4th Sunday of Advent, and then Mass on Christmas Eve for Christmas.** It would be very difficult to have our normal Sunday morning Masses, given the number of Masses that day. 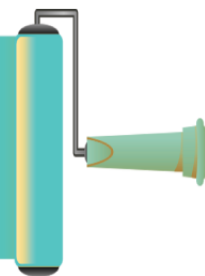
