### Souper Bowl of Caring 2018

<u>On Super Bowl weekend, February 3 & 4, 2018</u>, look for our young people standing with soup pots as you exit Church and help our inner city pantries purchase necessities and food.

During the game that night, think about those who go without food on a daily basis. By supporting this effort we all put a new meaning to Souper Bowl Sunday.

In St. Charles and St. Ann's church, anyone who is not able to come up in the Communion procession to receive the Eucharist, please know that a minister will come to you if you are seated in the pews at the back of the church.

If you are bringing Communion to the homebound or to a loved one, you must transport the host in a sacred vessel known as a pyx. That is the only proper way to carry the Eucharist. Please ask the priest or deacon for a pyx before Mass that you can use for this purpose.

If you have borrowed a pyx from the church, please return the pyx when you are finished with it so it may be used by others.

As you know, it is a great privilege to serve as a minister in the church. We always welcome new ministers. If you would like to be trained to serve as an altar server, lector, or Eucharistic Minister, we welcome and encourage you to do so. Please let Dc. Tony know.




