Respect Life

Certainly the philosophy of secular humanism (which denies the objective, extra-mental reality of God and insists that "man is the supreme being for man") provides a firm foundation for the anti-life mentality and such practices as abortion, infanticide, euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide. For if human life is not sacred, if man is not made in the image and likeness of God, then we may do away with innocent human life whenever it becomes convenient or profitable.

However, if we acknowledge the sacredness of human life and the reality of God-given rights and corresponding duties, then we must grant that the elderly, handicapped and innocent unborn babies have God-given, intrinsic moral worth and dignity and an unalienable right to life.



In St. Charles and St. Ann's church, anyone who is not able to come up in the Communion procession to receive the Eucharist, please know that a minister will come to you if you are seated in the pews at the back of the church.

If you are bringing Communion to the homebound or to a loved one, you must transport the host in a sacred vessel known as a pyx. That is the only proper way to carry the Eucharist. Please ask the priest or deacon for a pyx before Mass that you can use for this purpose.

If you have borrowed a pyx from the church, please return the pyx when you are finished with it so it may be used by others.

As you know, it is a great privilege to serve as a minister in the church. We always welcome new ministers. If you would like to be trained to serve as an altar server, lector, or Eucharistic Minister, we welcome and encourage you to do so. Please let De. Tony know.

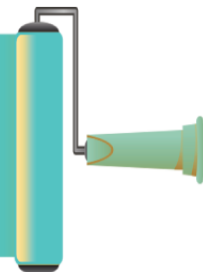
