

Lent is a time that those going through the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) more seriously prepare for the Easter sacraments through the disciplines of this penitential season.

During the 4:00 Mass at St. Patrick's on Saturday, Feb. 24th, we will celebrate the Rite of Continuing Conversion for our linked parishes' RCIA Candidate, Sherry Sheggrud. It is an opportunity for our expanded parish community to acknowledge and affirm Sherry as she begins the final stages that lead to full participation in the Catholic Church, which will take place at the Easter Vigil.

The RCIA Team hopes you will join us in this holy season in supporting Sherry through personal encouragement and prayer.

A huge thanks to our very generous parishioners of St. Charles-St. Ann's Parish and St. Patrick-St. Brigid Parish. On Super Bowl Sunday, teens from the parishes collected donations in large soup pots. That weekend is also known as The Souper Bowl of Caring. Churches across the country collect donations that go to area pantries and homeless shelters. Our teens collected \$1600 to be distributed to St. Brigid-St. Joseph's Food Pantry, Assumption Food Pantry, Cathedral Food Pantry and St. Lucy's Food Pantry. This money will be used to purchase toiletries like toothpaste, shampoo, soap and deodorant. These items are not available through the local Food Bank nor can they be purchased with food stamps. Thank you to our many teens, to the adults who helped at each Mass and to our generous parishioners. The pantries were overjoyed to hear that we used the most materialistic day of the year to think of them and their needs.

On Sunday evening, February 11th we were blessed to have Fr. Chris Ballard from Our Lady of Hope Church speak at our Family Faith Formation event for grades 8-12. Every aspect of that evening was so powerful! Fr. Chris started the evening off with a fun #hashtag power point on how social media would have been used in the time of Jesus. His talk continued by focusing on how we can develop a more meaningful and deeper relationship with Jesus. He used a perfect analogy of the how a 7th grader would handle dating and how that would change and deepen over the years of high school. It made perfect sense that our relationship with Jesus as a friend also needs to evolve and deepen. He spoke on the lives of the saints and how they modeled Christ's mission and led lives based solely on their love of God and love of those in need. But, Fr. Chris saved the best for last. He shared his life story and how he was called to become a priest. There is nothing more powerful than sharing a personal story - it moves people in so many ways. His story is a miracle and I personally left that night with a renewed hope in the ministry of the Church. My prayer and our prayers should be that God will continue to call young men to shepherd the people here in our communities. I believe men are being called, there could have been a few sitting in the pews that Sunday night and Fr. Chris's witness, his story and his passion did more than any vocation dinner, retreat or conference would do.

I was turned down by 3 other priests for very good reasons and I know now why that happened. I have to thank Father Kevin for directing me to contact Fr. Chris. The Pope and Bishop Cunningham have called the churches to focus on the family this year. Here at St. Charles-St. Ann's, we are trying very hard to do that. We had all of our students grades 8-12 there and mostly all of their parents and siblings...the Church was packed. It was a perfect way to jump start our Lenten journey. Our students and parents shared a few cookies, a final good-bye to Fr. Chris and I know they had plenty to talk about on their trip home.

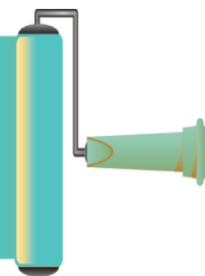
