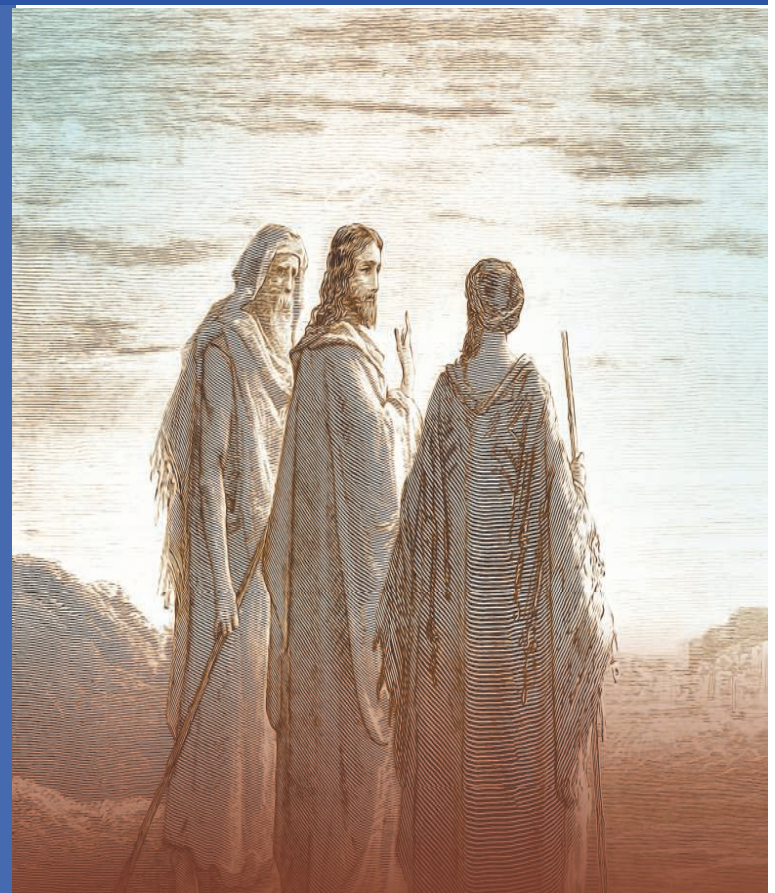

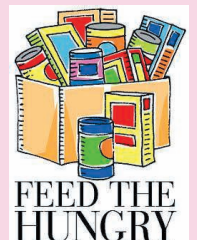

Parish Registration: Welcome to all new families and individuals. Please register as soon as possible. Registration forms and a welcome packet are available in the church office

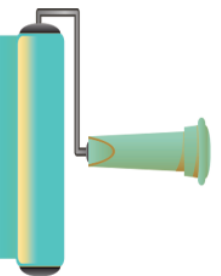
