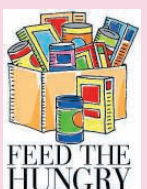

A long, cold, lasting winter is hard on everyone, but it is especially hard on farmers. By the end of April, crops are usually in the ground and already starting to show new life.

Winter has been hard on the Matthew 25 Farm. This past Monday, Mother Nature kicked off Spring and it was spectacular and warm and not a cloud in the sky!! Our YIM group of girls were eager to volunteer this past Monday to help plant and couldn't wait to get their hands into the dirt. The Matthew 25 Farm is a non-profit local farm which grows and donates all its crops to pantries in the surrounding area. The Farm has two locations, one in Vesper and one in LaFayette. Our Youth in Ministry works the Farm all summer – we love the fresh air but we love their Ministry more! Our job on Monday was to transplant 800 donated young tomato plants into the greenhouse trays. We also planted seeds of peppers, eggplants, cucumbers and other varieties into trays to start the growing process. We can't wait to go back and plant them into the fields and then harvest them! 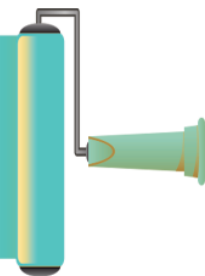
