The tomatoes, zucchini, yellow squash, cucumbers and gorgeous raspberries were picked over the weekend and delivered to several Food Pantries: The Rescue Mission, FM Fresh Air Food Pantry and St. Lucy's.

The Matthew 25 Farm is a non-for-profit Farm that relies on all volunteers to plant, tend and harvest all produce. Every crop planted is donated to Food Pantries in Syracuse and in the surrounding communities. Produce that is picked on the Farm goes from field to table in a couple of days. Our YIM high school youth group has already gone 3-4 times to plant and we are harvesting this week. We have worked the Farm for over 5 summers and our teens love going. Please consider volunteering or donating to this wonderful ministry of feeding the needy. - The Catholic church has long recognized the dignity of the human person from the moment of conception until natural death. Assisted suicide compromises the dignity of the individual and does not protect life.
