



We traveled down to the North side and toured the Free Health Clinic. The Food Pantry and the Soup Kitchen. We learned so much about the care and compassion that the Franciscan brothers and sisters provide to those in need on the North Side. It is a haven of Christ's compassion and care. Over 22 doctors volunteer at the Health Clinic along with Nurses and Physician Assistants. They also have a Free Law Clinic where lawvers also volunteer and every Tuesday evening our very own Rosemary Monticello, 95 years young, sits at the desk to help out! Service is lifelong and we are called by Christ to take care of our neighbors - this day was a great introduction to what will hopefully be a lifetime of service.


