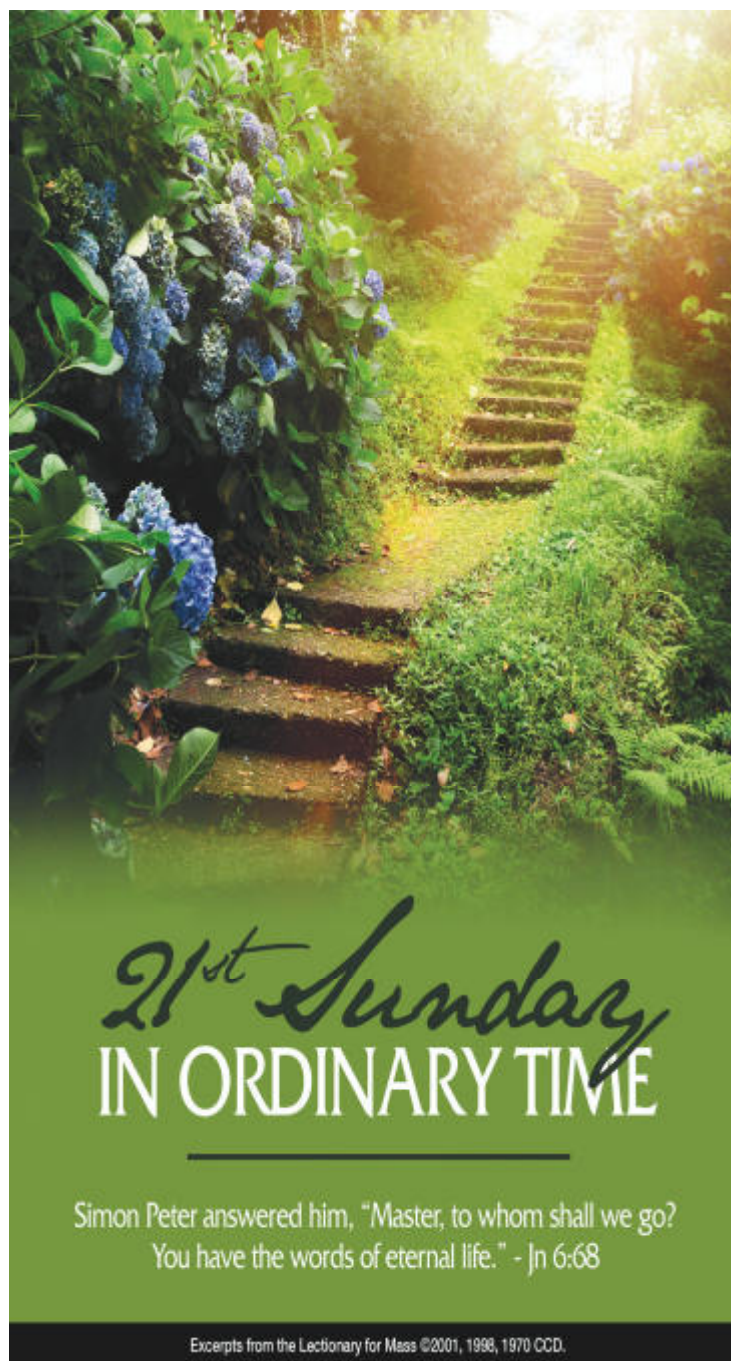

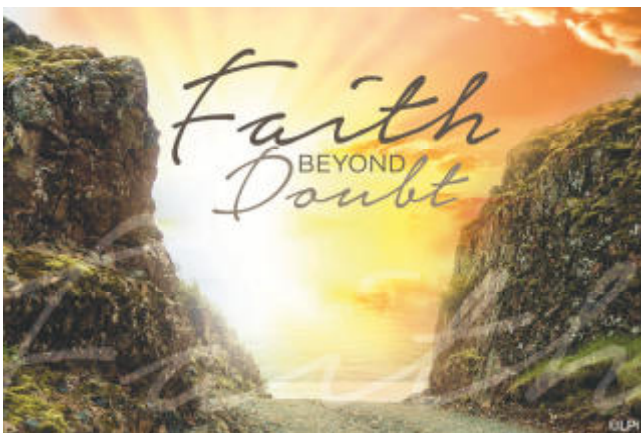

It is one of our favorite experiences and thanks to one of our Moms, Lorraine Fountain, who helped out, we were able to visit the Franciscan Northside Ministries. We first baked breads in the Ministry Center to donate for the Street Coffee Hour with Sr. Dolly and then we had a lesson on Social Justice and Works of Charity. We traveled down to the North side and toured the Free Health Clinic, The Food Pantry and the Soup Kitchen. We learned so much about the care and compassion that the Franciscan brothers and sisters provide to those in need on the North Side. It is a haven of Christ's compassion and care. Over 22 doctors volunteer at the Health Clinic along with Nurses and Physician Assistants. They also have a Free Law Clinic where lawyers also volunteer and every Tuesday evening our very own Rosemary Monticello, 95 years young, sits at the desk to help out! Service is lifelong and we are called by Christ to take care of our neighbors - this day was a great introduction to what will hopefully be a lifetime of service.

## RESPECT LIFE

While the number of abortion facilities in the United States, now around 700, declines, the number of pro-life pregnancy centers is growing. More than 1,100 pregnancy centers in the United States now offer ultrasound services in addition to the traditional model of counseling and material aid. About 100 additional centers are converting to a limited medical model each year, and many clinics are expanding to provide comprehensive health care services from a pro-life perspective.
