Respect Life

A few years before she died, Mother Teresa spoke before the National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, DC. Normally, most speakers avoid controversy and stay on safe topics. Mother Teresa, however, weighed in on a truly sensitive issue. She told the audience, "The greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion, because it is...against.. The innocent child. " She stated that the way to persuade a woman not to have an abortion was simple: "as always we must persuade her with love, and we remind ourselves that love means to be willing to give until it hurts. Jesus gave even his life to love us. So, the mother who is thinking of abortion should be helped to love, that is, to give until it hurts her plans, and to respect the life of her child. The father of that child, whoever he is, must also give until it hurts.

Praying the rosary, silent meditation and Benediction.


