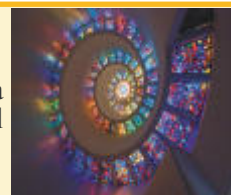
Grade 8 classes will begin on September 30th at 6pm at St. Ann's. We ask that all 8th grade students and at least one parent meet in the Church that evening.

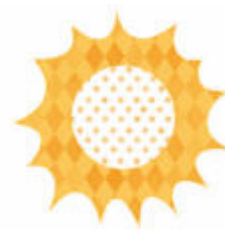
