## St. Charles-St. Ann Parish

Parishioners of St. Charles-St. Ann,

As we welcome Bishop-Elect Lucia let me share with you some of the daunting tasks that await him. Much has changed in our Diocese in the last number of years. In particular the number and age of our priests. The Diocese just released the following figures:

Active Diocesan Priests	94
Retired Priests	77
Retired Priests still active	35
Number under 60 years old	33
Number over 60 years old	61
Mean age of "active" priests	65
Median age of "active" priests	62
Number of Canonical Parishes	114

These numbers are projected to July 1, 2019

The parishes are divided into 11 Pastoral Care Areas and much work continues to merge and combine parish communities. May the Holy Spirit guide our new Bishop with the daunting decisions he will need to make with our support.

### RESPECT LIFE

With the extreme "Reproductive Health Act" rushed to passage without hearings and signed into law for political points on January 22, the Legislature and Governor made sure that no law, no matter how reasonable or supported by the public, would remain on the books in New York to protect unborn children and their moms.
