It includes the Pope's prayer intentions for the month and a short video if you choose to watch it. It also includes morning, afternoon and evening prayers for you to pray. You will also see a place to put your prayer intentions and to read prayer requests from all over the world. It helps us to understand that we are all one no matter where we live!! "Instead of being just a church that welcomes and receives by keeping the doors open, let us try also to be a church that finds new roads, that is able to step outside itself and go to those who do not attend Mass, to those who have quit or are indifferent." — Pope Francis

These are informal "Come and See" opportunities for both those of different or no faiths who might be interested in learning more about becoming Catholic, as well as those Pope Francis refers to as currently on different roads.

If you know someone that fits either of these descriptions, please consider inviting them to attend these sessions...and even accompanying them!

Sessions will be held on Oct. 20, 27, and Nov. 3....the RCIA Team looks forward to finding new roads together ...because to quote Pope Francis again: "Faith is only worth having when you give it away."
