"Instead of being just a church that welcomes and receives by keeping the doors open, let us try also to be a church that finds new roads, that is able to step outside itself and go to those who do not attend Mass, to those who have quit or are indifferent." — Pope Francis

Many of us think of the Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA) as a way to bring non-Catholics into the fullness of our faith. That's true...to a point. But it's also the way to bring back those who have chosen for one reason or another not to join us in living out their lives in the fullness of the Catholic faith which they received at Baptism. It's also for adults who might have made their First Communion, but have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Beginning Oct. 20th, we will be holding Inquiry sessions after the 8:00 Mass at St. Ann's in the Parish Ministry Center (the former convent). These are informal "Come and See" opportunities for both those of different or no faiths who might be interested in learning more about becoming Catholic, as well as those Pope Francis refers to as currently on different roads.

Attendance at Mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.


