Blessings in a Backpack is a non-profit organization that feeds school children in the United States who currently are fed during the week on the federally funded Free and Reduced Meal Program and are at risk of going hungry on the weekends. Its mission is to mobilize communities, individuals, and resources to provide food on the weekends for elementary school children across America who might otherwise go hungry. The program works with elementary school-aged children whose families cannot afford enough food. Better test scores, improved reading skills, positive behavior, improved health and increased attendance have all been attributed to the success of this program.

Once again we have been asked to help our school children in this program. The teachers and social workers designate what families will benefit from this.

Sessions will be held on Oct. 20, 27, and Nov. 3...the RCIA Team looks forward to finding new roads together ...because to quote Pope Francis again: "Faith is only worth having when you give it away."

Sr. Brigid O'Mahony breaks open the meaning of Scripture and how we can apply it to our lives. Our next Bible Study will be October 12th and 19th from 9-11am in the Media Room at St. Ann's.
