



It was a magical morning, filled with laughter, singing, coloring, sharing snacks and reading together! One of the teachers came up to me and said, " I know these children and this will probably be the only gift they receive this Christmas". She was moved to tears and just could not believe how amazing this was!!

We especially want to thank Westhill High School for bussing the teens to and from Franklin - without their help, this project would not happen. Thanks also to the students of West Genesee High School who collected reading books for the 120 Second graders - they loved the books! 




