### **Respect Life**

Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann of Kansas City, Kansas, urged members of Congress in an Oct. 31 letter to support the Dignity for Aborted Children Act, calling it "a reasonable, common ground response to ensure that all human remains including the bodily remains of an aborted child, are treated with dignity and respect." The bill, which requires abortion providers to respectfully dispose of the remains of unborn children, was introduced in the Senate following the discovery in September of the remains of 2,246 aborted babies in the home of now-deceased abortionist Dr. Ulrich "George" Klopfer. We pray that legislators will listen to the Archbishop's words and concede that "as a nation, we can at least come together to ensure all human remains are treated with basic human dignity."
