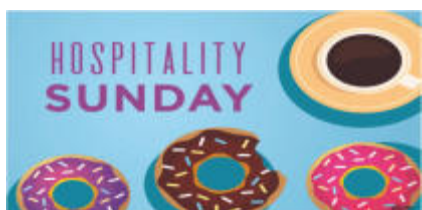

Respect Life

A new Marist Poll, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus, shows a strong majority of Americans want to elect candidates who support abortion restrictions. The same poll indicated most Americans still reject the reasoning for the U.S. Supreme Court's Roe v. Wade decision. The Knights of Columbus reported that "more than 6 in 10 Americans (62%) say that if the Supreme Court revisits Roe v. Wade, it should rule to allow states to determine restrictions (46%) or make abortion illegal (16%) . Only 33% of Americans say Roe v. Wade should be interpreted to allow for legal abortion any time without restriction. The poll shows that while legislation is being enacted by politicians with extreme views on abortion, a majority of Americans believe that, at minimum, regulations should be in place to protect the lives of the unborn.

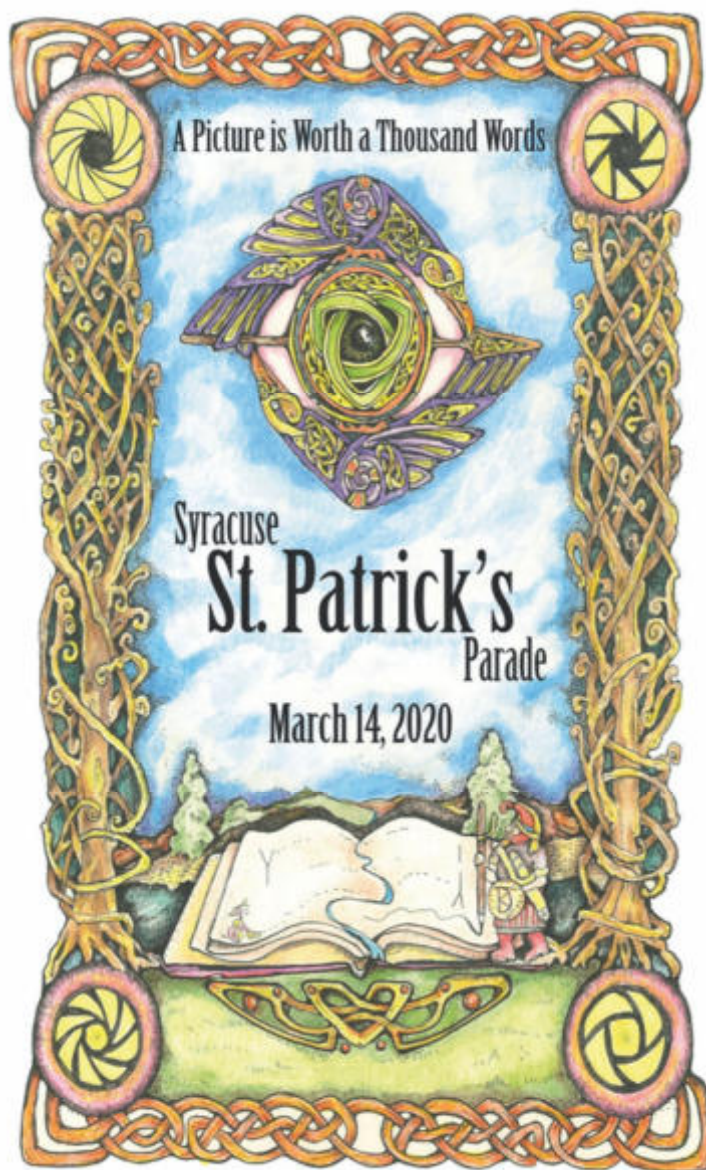
