On Thursday evening, April 27th, our Parish was honored to have the Most Rev. Thomas J. Costello confirm our young men and women candidates. The Bishop was joined by our Pastor, Father Brian, Msgr. James Lang and Deacon Tony Paratore. Our candidates were dressed in their finest and all present could feel the power of the Spirit. Our class of candidates renewed their Baptismal promises enthusiastically. Bishop Costello then asked all the congregation and celebrants to sit in silent prayer for 2 minutes to call on the Holy Spirit. The candidates were asked to kneel as everyone present stretched forth their hands as the Bishop prayed the Prayer of the Seven Gifts. It was very powerful and very moving. The candidates were then anointed with the Holy Chrism. Chrism is scented with balsam and used at Baptism, Confirmation and to anoint Bishops and Priests. Completing what Baptism started, Confirmation is the seal of the faith on a Catholic Christian.

The Bishop spoke to the candidates very passionately about their role in the Church. He told them that they were not the Church of the future, they were the Church of the present. He said that Pope Francis would be very proud of all their work in reaching out to the poor and meeting them face-to-face. He spoke that this was the beginning of their active adult ministry in the church. He called each to pray and listen to God's call as they discerned their path in life.
