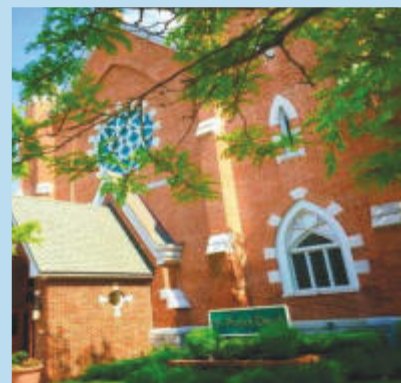

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear St. Charles-St. Ann's & St. Patrick's and St. Brigid's Parishioners,

I hope and pray that you have been staying safe during the COVID pandemic. I cannot begin to express just how much I miss seeing you! This pandemic has certainly affected all areas of our lives including our church. We are currently operating under diocesan guidelines and only able to have 33% capacity at all of our masses. This means that St. Charles can only hold 150 people for ANY mass, St. Ann's can only hold 75 people, and St. Patrick's/St. Brigid's only 125 people. At all of our masses, people must wear a mask and wear it the entire time they are in the church building. We have also roped off every other pew and people are required to stay six feet apart from each other. We are alternating sides for the distribution of holy communion as well to keep people properly distanced. We also have to turn off the air conditioning before mass begins so as not to circulate the air in the building. After each mass, the church(es) are sanitized in every way possible. We are doing everything possible so as to keep everyone safe. Having to follow all the guidelines is challenging and fortunately we have an excellent staff to meet those challenges! I cannot thank them enough for keeping us safe!

Given these guidelines, we have had to change our mass schedule. The bishop not only wants to keep our parishioners safe, but his priests as well! We have limited the number of masses to keep everyone safe. Therefore, we will not be holding any weekend masses at St. Ann's because it can only hold a very limited number of people given the current guidelines. If these guidelines change, we will look into changing the mass schedule.

As we've mentioned to our St. Charles-St. Ann's parishioners in the past, we are currently having both of our church properties assessed so we can better determine the future of our parish community. When we have more information on anything related to future changes, we will let you know.

Thank you so much for your prayers, support, and understanding during this time!

Very often, the only nutritious meal many children receive is from their school.

Blessings in a backpack will continue to send food home with at risk students each weekend to get them through until they return on Monday.

The COVID pandemic has changed the world as we knew it, and our inner city children are the hardest hit. *In the Syracuse city school district, breakfast to 11,000 kids are provided every day, lunches to 15,000 kids every day and on weekends thanks to the collaboration that is ongoing with community agencies and with the Blessing Program.*
